- 2 The filter bar allows you to search for individual vessels, or to refine the list by incident type, casualty location, cause of casualty or casualty date.
- 3 You can also see more filters, including vessel details and casualty details by selecting 'More Filters'.  
Vessel details filters allow you to refine your search by flag, class, different types of owners and operators etc.  
Filtering by casualty details allows you to select loss type, casualty age, number of dead, missing and injured.
- 4 Depending on your subscription type, you can export your data into Excel using the 'Export table' button.
